## THIS BULLETIN RETRACTS THE CEREMONY OF WISHES OF JANUARY 9, 2025 WITH THE INTERVENTIONS BY VARIOUS ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES

Presence of Mr. Deputy Prefect, Arnaud BOURDA, of Madam and Sir the departmental councilors, Christine GONZATO-ROQUES and Marcel CALMETTE, of Mr. President of the community of communes, Auguste FLORIO, of mayors of the community of communes, of gendarmes including Commander TRENTIN and Major DUCROCQ and firefighters including the head of the center Laurent GRAFEILLE, of presidents of Monflanquin associations, of Mrs. Florence DUPRAT, director of the EHPAD, of the priest Venant SAMBA and of the pastor Adrew ROSSITER.

Thank you all for coming.

First of all, I would like to send you my best wishes for this year 2025, that it may be for all of you but also for everyone a year where solidarity, attention to others and to our environment are not empty words.

This week marks the 10th anniversary of the Charlie Hebdo massacre and then the Hyper Cacher massacre. I will just quote a sentence from Jean-Noël JEANMEY, historian and former director of Radio France: "It is up to democracy alone to inflexibly defend the freedom to think, speak, write and draw, simply because this touches on the intimacy of its raison d'être." Our municipalities are the first level of this democracy.

The general context does not inspire enthusiasm, but in these troubled times, we must appreciate how lucky we are to live here.

Monflanquin is a beautiful, very large commune, almost 63 km2 with several hamlets, Corconat, Roquefère, Calviac, Labarthe and Lamothe-Feyt and the main village, a 13th century fortified town, Most Beautiful Village in France since 1989 and a green resort since 1965. A rural commune open to the world.

We have a rich heritage, stones, know-how, landscapes that we work with all the teams to preserve and enhance.

We also have 43 municipal buildings, significant sports infrastructure and a pleasant living environment; a controlled operating budget of 2.4 million euros and we manage to maintain a significant level of investment, 500,000 euros minimum, despite the economic situation.

A clarification: we have 26 full-time municipal agent positions, municipalities with the same number of inhabitants have on average 6 additional positions, i.e. 19% more than us...

After this introductory remarks, you will understand the essential role of our municipal agents because the work and investment necessary to make everything work are, to say the least, also very substantial.

It is important to introduce them to you.

**Most Beautiful Village in France**, since 1989.  
**Bastide**

Membership of the departmental association and the federation.

**Flowerly village**, 2 flowers at the regional level  
Demanding specifications, respect for the environment, water savings, perennial plants, etc.

**Small towns of tomorrow** with Cancon, Castillonès and Villeréal, this label can allow for more substantial funding from the State.

### Family fishing

Adapted pontoon and secure areas around Lake Coulon, in partnership with the fishing company.

**Committed organic territory**, on two counts:

More than 30% of organic products served in school meals, we are at around 50% (organic, local, no "industrialized" dishes).

More than 8% of useful agricultural area is organic, we are at around 11%.

**Green station**, since 1965.

We hosted the 24th congress in 2024 for the 60th anniversary of the label.

**WORK IN PROGRESS AND TO COME**

The Halte, the town hall hall, 32 rue de l'Union, the Coulon pavilions, the Tonnelle and the heating network.



**The 2 pavilions of Coulon**

These two former bungalows of the Monform hotel, owned by the municipality since the sale of the site, have been rehabilitated with the help of the Compagnons Bâisseurs.

They provide a functional and pleasant welcome for lifeguards in the summer and currently for 2 months for a general practitioner as a replacement at the MSP.

The various permits have been filed or are in the process of being filed by HABITALYS (departmental social landlord) which is responsible for all the real estate work and future rental management.

The municipality acquired the property (intermediation of the Public Land Establishment) and will ensure the design and maintenance of the public green spaces on the hillside.

The road development necessary to secure access will be carried out in close collaboration with the Department's services.

The financing plan for this great operation is entirely sustainable thanks to the energy invested by Nathalie FOUNAUD-VEYSSET and Nathalie LONGY in developing the file.

**ECONOMY**

Our local economy maintains a close link with the farmers of the commune. The sustainability of the Thursday market all year round as well as the success of the producers' markets during the summer season are examples of this.

Trade and crafts are also the economic lungs of our territory and for them to function, each of us must be a responsible local consumer.

We will note 7 installations in 2024! Welcome to the new ones and thank you to those who have exercised their right to retirement.

We are also fortunate to have home help services, available and competent health professionals in our area. The EHPAD René ANDRIEU welcomes with professionalism and respect around 80 people, most of whom are attached to our town.

Community life contributes to the town's appeal and vitality.

Maintaining a high level of subsidy, logistical facilities (catering, accommodation, etc.) and the provision of municipal agents demonstrate the importance that municipal elected officials attach to the voluntary sector: may all administrators and volunteers accept our thanks and encouragement to continue!

**SERVICES TO RESIDENTS**

The team of France Service agents, with the support of the State and a strong commitment from the municipality, carried out 3,500 support operations in 2024, an average of 13 per day: this demonstrates the need to maintain as many public services as possible in our village, even if this requires budgetary efforts (employees, works, etc.).

The digital advisor has carried out 1,300 digital usage initiations: his work allows everyone to access essential digital skills today, with kindness and education.

The CNI (National Identity Card) and passport service at the town hall, run jointly with the commune of Cancon, is starting to be in high demand and responds to a clearly identified need in the community of communes.



**The heat network**

The heating network was set up in 2024. The Daniel SOULAGE community hall is its heart, it irrigates the community nursery and the headquarters of the community of communes, to come the Tonnelle and the former CFA.

We see the consequences of climate change every day, hence the interest in this type of project. Another one will be studied for the buildings of Cap del Pech.

**The Arbor Project**



As a reminder, this site will host 8 so-called shared housing units for senior tenants who express the desire to live at home in the heart of the town while sharing chosen moments with their neighbors. La Tonnelle is one of the 13 winners of the call for projects from the Departmental Council (subsidy of 110,000 euros). 6 apartments will also be offered for traditional rental at moderate rent.

**THE MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL: A SUMMER SUCCESS**

With a summer marked by mild weather, the municipal swimming pool has seen a large number of visitors this season. The ideal conditions have largely benefited the site's attendance and finances, as evidenced by an increase in the number of entries.

In July, no fewer than 4,732 visitors passed through the site's doors, while in August the figure climbed to 5,751 entries. That is a total of 2,774 more visitors than last year.

The repair of the water lines in June only served to increase the appeal of this swimming pool, which is always perfectly maintained by municipal agents.

Special mention also goes to Hélià RABOT and Éponine MERIGOT who, in July and August respectively, were able to welcome the public with an impeccable smile at the checkout.

The swimming pool will be open to bathers next summer for a new season.

**SPORTS INFRASTRUCTURE: SUBSTANTIAL INVESTMENTS**

The municipality continues its commitment to sports infrastructure, with facilities dedicated to rugby, football, tennis, pétanque, and many other disciplines.

These spaces have benefited from major work this year.

Tennis was particularly in the spotlight, despite a rainy spring delaying some work, no less than 50,000 euros were invested for:

- 📍 The complete renovation of courts 1 and 2.
- 📍 The transformation of court 3.
- 📍 The renovation of the summer clubhouse, including a new roof and better insulation.
- 📍 Consideration is also being given to modernizing court 4.

In addition, other promising projects are emerging on the horizon:

- 📍 The creation of a City Stadium, to further diversify sporting activities accessible to all.
- 📍 The switch to LED lighting on the rugby pitch, combined with new modern lighting.
- 📍 A reflection on the renovation of the stands of the rugby stadium, to better accommodate supporters.

## SCHOOLS: REVIEW OF THE YEAR 2024

This year again, our schools have been at the heart of the life of our community, as evidenced by their participation in the reconstruction of the painting "Children's Games" by Pieter BRUEGHEL, produced on the Place des Arcades last June on the occasion of Janouille's 30th anniversary.

We are fortunate to have two dynamic establishments: a nursery school with 65 students and an elementary school with 108 students, for a total of 173 children enrolled. These numbers demonstrate the vitality of our community and the importance of our schools for our families.

We would also like to highlight a significant departure: Mrs. TONON, who, after many years with our children, has taken a well-deserved retirement. We would like to thank her again for her commitment and dedication.

The municipality continues to invest heavily to provide the best possible conditions for our students. Each year, 150,000 euros are paid into the school fund. Added to this, this year, 40,000 euros of work to improve and maintain our schools.

Another key focus of our action concerns school catering, thanks to our central kitchen. We are continuing our commitment to local, diversified and quality food, with today more than 40% of organic products in our children's meals.

Finally, we would like to express our gratitude to all the teaching staff, municipal agents and teams who work hard every day to support our children in their learning and well-being.

## COMMUNAL LABEL OF HOUSES AND GARDENS FLOWERED

Who says our traditional SAINT ANDRÉ, says the pleasure of thanking the 13 Monflanquinois(es) selected as part of the communal label.

It was under a beautiful sun that we gave each person a plant in the presence of Mr. the Sub-Prefect – Arnaud BOURDA who enthusiastically lent himself to the game of thanks for the second year, Mr. Guillaume LEPERS was also present. Photo page 5.

Our choice of reward fell on St. John's wort, a perennial plant, very floriferous and not very water-hungry.

As part of respect for the environment, the jury pays particular attention to:

- ÿ the choice of plants that require little water,
- ÿ mulching the ground or pots,
- ÿ the transition from annuals to perennial plants, preferably flowering,
- ÿ the recommendation, when possible, of planting them in open ground,
- ÿ replacing plastic (pots, etc.) with natural materials,
- ÿ the flowering of vegetable gardens.

These efforts are also implemented by our green spaces department. We would like to thank them for this. Our town is beautiful but large and their work is substantial both in terms of its maintenance and its development.

On this subject, this year, in addition to the renovation of many flowerbeds, the development of a new hedge made of flowering perennials around the city has seen the light of day to replace the boxwood eaten by the box tree moth. The future should promise us a nice visual and pleasant scents.

The chestnut tree, cut down at the top of rue Saint Pierre, was replaced by a maple tree on the occasion of the 60th anniversary of the green stations and 7 "baby" rose bushes "Most Beautiful Villages of France" were planted, one in Monflanquin and the others in our six hamlets.

## INFORMATION CEMETERIES

The development, maintenance and management of our heritage also concerns our 8 cemeteries.

We are in this dynamic and we have continued, this year with 2 procedures for the resumption of concessions in a state of abandonment\* and burials in common ground\* which concern for the moment, the old and the new cemetery of Monflanquin:

ÿ \*The first is finished and a work study is in progress course.

ÿ \*The second will end in December 2025.

This restoration work will make it possible to meet the demands of certain residents and make these cemeteries more visually pleasing.

After their grassing which brings a little freshness to these very mineralized places, we are also starting to put in place a little vegetation such as the planting of 6 "Most Beautiful Villages in France" rose bushes and some small perennials.

**Little reminder:** the census of all the concessions is still in progress and this work corresponds to approximately 1,000 burials.

It also concerns the cemeteries of CALVIAC, CORCONAT, LABARTHE, LAMOTHE-FEY, SAINT HILAIRE and ROQUEFERE.

I thank the families who helped me update their dealership files and invite others to contact me.

## IDENTITY CARDS AND PASSPORTS

Monflanquin town hall welcomes you, by appointment only, for the renewal or establishment of your identity cards and passports.

You can start this process 6 months before the expiration date on your title. This way, you can be sure that your title is up to date when you need it!

Online pre-application for a passport or national identity card, <https://passeport.ants.gouv.fr/demarches-en-ligne>, does not exempt you from going personally to submit the application to the town hall. This is a security measure to prevent identity theft.

## FACADES SUBSIDY AND JOINERY

The municipality of Monflanquin is offering financial assistance for the renovation of facades in the heart of the town in order to help beautify the village, preserve its architectural heritage and encourage owners to invest in the renovation of their properties.

Here are the main terms of this grant:

• The municipality covers 25% of the total amount of the work (excluding taxes), with a ceiling of 1,500 euros per request.

• The grant applies to the renovation of facades and joinery.

• Owners must have obtained all necessary administrative authorizations before starting work.

• Payment of the grant is conditional on the work complying with the authorizations granted.
