Given the general context, we can enjoy and savor the fact of being able to live in our region and community of municipalities.

We are very pleased to welcome Pierre-Louis BOURNOVILLE, the new doctor at the MONFLANQUIN health center.

Two associations, DESCARATZ and LE BELVEDERE, have decided to locate their headquarters in MONFLANQUIN. This is another opportunity to highlight the rich and diverse community fabric in our town, which continues to grow in all areas.

All the activities and events throughout the seasons demonstrate this to us and the summer period will, once again, allow us to appreciate our summer "emblematic" events such as the Baroque Evenings and the Medieval festivals and I would like to thank all of our municipal agents for their investment in these events.

Our town remains attractive and lively all year round, even though, of course, July and August are the months when we have the most visitors and holidaymakers.

Dynamism is also evident when new facilities are added. We are delighted to welcome two additional art galleries, a brasserie in the heart of the bastide, and a "boutique et délices" at 59 Route de Villeneuve.

Consuming local products is obviously important to promote and develop our "territorial network".

I thank the street vendors and producers who come every Thursday morning, all year round. This weekly market is a real treasure, and it's in everyone's interest to support it. On July 3, the Thursday evening farmers' markets will begin and will run until September 4. The "small summer markets" organized by the ACAM are scheduled to be held on Sunday mornings at the entrance to the bastide starting Sunday, June 29.

There is rarely any synchronization between "administrative time" and "elected officials' time," but municipal projects are moving forward. The contract for the City Stade (sports ground, on the former basketball court) will be launched. The development of the "garden" and the Tonnelle parking lot, under the responsibility of the municipality, is under study and "well underway," and the building permit for 32 rue de l'Union (accessible to France Services and Espace Numérique) must be submitted before the summer.

While some events are organized jointly with associations, such as the music festival with ACAV, others are organized directly by the town hall, such as July 14th, open-air cinema, concerts, etc., you will find in this bulletin the entire "intense" program for the days and months to come.

## The Recycling Corner

Setting up a "Recycling Corner" in each recycling center to enable reuse and provide a positive solution by creating a clean and tidy space.

The principle: everyone has seen something at the recycling center they'd like to recover, and everyone has thrown away something that could still be useful. To accommodate these rapid recoveries, the CCBHAP set up dedicated recycling areas in 2025 where residents can freely and freely drop off and recover items.

## Video surveillance

Video surveillance of voluntary drop-off points: a system to combat fly-tipping.

Faced with the increase in antisocial behaviour and fly-tipping around voluntary drop-off points (VDPs), the community of communes has decided to strengthen surveillance of these areas by gradually installing video surveillance cameras.

This measure aims to prevent disrespectful behavior, improve the cleanliness of sites and reduce management costs borne by the community.

As a reminder, the abandonment or illegal dumping of waste at collection points or on public roads constitutes an offense, punishable by a fine of a minimum of €250 and up to €1,500, or even more in the event of aggravating circumstances (Article R.632-1 of the Criminal Code).

This system is part of a comprehensive approach to environmental preservation, respect for public spaces, and empowering users. The municipality thanks all residents who properly sort and dispose of their waste, thereby contributing to a cleaner and more sustainable living environment.



In view of the State's financial restrictions, the person in charge of this departmental label informed us that there would be no selection or award ceremony this year, 2025.

## **RESTORATION OF THE RETAINING WALL ON THE TOWN TOWER IN** MONFLANQUIN

The municipality of Monflanguin recently began work to restore the retaining wall located on the Tour de Ville, following an incident that weakened the structure

In fact, this wall had been damaged by a vehicle, which caused the structure to sink and compromised its solidity. In order to guarantee the safety of users, an intervention was necessary.

The company Pascal SCULLIER, specializing in masonry and stone cutting, was commissioned to carry out this renovation in accordance with traditional techniques and local aesthetics.

## INFORMATION **CEMETERIES**

The Monflanguin Town Hall's green spaces team, Nicolas, Éric, and Dylan, are responsible for maintaining the Monflanguin cemeteries. Numerous operations are carried out throughout the vear

- ÿ In May and June: every 10 days,

ÿ In July, August and September, approximately every 15 days, variable depending on the weather.

It takes the team 36 hours to mow the eight cemeteries. It only works on municipal property. The concession holder (or their beneficiaries) must maintain their concession and the plants planted there.

These should under no circumstances cover the intergraves or invade neighboring plots. It is also reminded that any potted flowers must be placed in the containers reserved for this purpose. Thank you for your attention and understanding

## FACADES SUBSIDY AND JOINERY

The municipality of Monflanquin is offering financial assistance for the renovation of facades in the heart of the town in order to help beautify the village, preserve its architectural heritage and encourage owners to invest in the renovation of their properties.

## Here are the main terms of this grant:

 $\ddot{y}$  The municipality covers 25% of the total cost of the work (excluding taxes), with a ceiling of 1,500 euros per request.

ÿ The grant applies to the renovation of facades and woodwork.

 $\ddot{y}$  Owners must have obtained all necessary administrative authorizations before starting work.

 $\ddot{y}$  Payment of the grant is conditional on the work complying with the authorizations granted.

For more information, it is advisable to contact Monflanquin town hall directly.

WORKS IN THE BASTIDE

Work is banned in the town of Monflanquin during the summer.

For reasons of public safety and good order, all work is prohibited in the center of Monflanquin **from June 15 to September 15** each year. This measure aims to prevent accidents due to the significant increase in the number of visitors in July and August.

However, in the event of a proven emergency, exceptional authorizations may be granted by the Mayor of Monflanquin.

Parking prohibited on Place des Arcades, traffic on Rue Saint Pierre side from June 1 to September 30.
