EDITORIAL

Our "high tourist season" went well even though the weather was a bit unpredictable this summer. The intense heat accompanied the "Medieval Festival".

July was not always a pleasant month, while June was very hot... It is clear that we will have to adapt as best we can to these differences which, a priori, will punctuate our daily lives.

There were still many holidaymakers, but turnover suffered from the "instability" of the general context and... the temperatures!

I would like to thank again and again all the volunteers thanks to whom the summer activities and events continue and take on professional dimensions while remaining friendly.

Our return to school, with a record participation for the Foulées Monflanquinoises, also went well both at the level of schools and leisure, cultural and sports associations.

On the sports field, stadium lighting is currently being installed, as is the City Stadium on the former basketball court. We should officially inaugurate it on St. Andrew's Day.

We decided with the head of the central kitchen, Alexandre PREZ and all the school stakeholders to set up two catering services during the lunch-two.

This measure was made possible thanks to the intervention of young people on work-study programs at the BHAP 4 cantons rugby club. Combined with the soundproofing of the Levant room, it offers greater comfort to children and supervisory staff.

Work at "La Tonnelle" and 32, rue de l'Union should also begin shortly, even though, as I have already said and written, "the timescales of the administration and those of elected officials do not often coincide." As a reminder, we voted on the agreement with the Établissement Public Foncier de Nouvelle Aquitaine in 2021, France Services was installed at 32, rue de l'Union in 2021, and we knew that energy renovation work would be necessary. The first grant application file dates from December 2020.

On September 21st, at the Coulon rugby stadium, a tribute was paid to a "Monflanguinois of stature", Robert GALLET, who left us this summer and whom we will not forget.

This August, we were very touched by the visit of the ALFARAJ family whom we welcomed upon their arrival from Syria in 2017. The whole family is doing well, the children are continuing their studies and the older ones are now owners of a garage in the Paris region.

Two anniversaries marked the beginning of this month of September 2025:

- The 90th anniversary of the Monflanguin fire station in the presence of the Deputy Prefect of the Villeneuve-sur-Lot district, Dalila ZANE, as well as the vice-president of the SDIS. Marcel CALMETTE.
- The 40th anniversary of the VITAMONT company, in the presence of the Deputy Prefect, Guillaume LEPERS, MP for the constituency, the President of the Departmental Council, Sophie BORDERIE, the two departmental councilors and the president of the CCBHAP. Also present were Eric BOCQUIER, director of VITAMONT, the founding president of Léa Nature, Charles KLOBOUKOFF and Alain BRUGALIERES, founder of the Monflanguin company.

This end of September, we were invited for the 3rd year to the Nicolaos Tselementes gastronomic festival in Siphnos.

The twinning committee is increasingly welcoming new members, and we thank them for their involvement and for organizing the trip. We will be hosting a delegation from this beautiful Greek island in the western Cyclades for this St. Andrew's Day 2025.

The furniture in the town hall reception area has been updated. It is now much more ergonomic and suitable.

I would like to warmly thank Carole IRIGOYEN, Michel REIGNE and Valentin, president of the association "l'univers de Léo" for offering us the beautiful photo of Léo, "the bumblebee", public prize at St André 2024. It has found its place at the town hall reception.

We always regret the closure of businesses, especially in the heart of the village, which we do our best to "protect." They are, throughout the year, an integral part of village life. This is why it is very important to remain attentive to consuming local products and to continue to support our local businesses and artisans. I thank you for this.

I wish you all the best for the end of the year and look forward to meeting you at the Bastide Festival on October 25 and 26, and at St Andrew's Day 2025, which will begin on Friday, November 28.

18th Monflanquinoises Races: A record participation in the sun!

On Sunday, September 7, the Coulon site vibrated to the rhythm of the 18th Foulées Monflanquinoises, a sporting event that has become a must in our town. In ideal weather, nearly 400 participants took part in the various events, breaking the participation record!



The courses, similar to those of last year and perfectly dry, allowed the runners to achieve very good times.

In the 12 km, which saw 191 finishers, the women's victory went to Amélie Navarre, who won by just 3 minutes, in 1 hour 01 minutes.

The 20 km long course (with a 350 m elevation gain) was the scene of a feat: Matteo BLESZ, a young athlete from Gers, broke the event record in 1 hour 21 minutes, leaving the 141 runners at the start far behind.

The 5 km race brought together 51 participants, while 70 walkers enjoyed the exceptional setting of our region. Finally, around fifty children also took part in this wonderful morning of sport.

All participants were able to enjoy a visit to the village, crossing our local landscapes and admiring magnificent residences and castles.

The event took place in a warm and friendly atmosphere, without any errors, thanks to a well-oiled organization.

New rugby posts for the start of the season

Brand new posts have just been installed by the Mérigoux construction company, just in time for the start of the new sports season.

Review of the summer season at the municipal swimming pool

As every year, the municipal swimming pool opened its doors on the last weekend of June to welcome swimmers until August 31.

At reception, Hélia RABOT and Éponine MERIGOT managed the entrances, while lifeguards Francis ANDRAC and Gérard SOBRINO were in charge of monitoring the pools, supported by Enrico BERNARDINI, lifeguard. The municipality warmly thanks them for their professionalism and dedication throughout the season.

In terms of attendance, the swimming pool recorded:

- 2,860 entries in July
- 4,586 entries in August

This represents a total of 7,446 entries for summer 2025.

By comparison, the 2024 season recorded 10,483 admissions, an exceptional figure linked to the temporary closure of the swimming pool at the Pierre et Vacances residence. The comparison with 2023 (7,709 admissions) is therefore more relevant: attendance in 2025 shows a slight decrease of 263 admissions.

Despite this reduction, the pool remains an essential place of conviviality and relaxation for locals and vacationers alike. We hope that the 2026 season will be even sunnier and more popular!

Robert GALLET has just left us at the age of 78.

Everyone knew Robert, who was — and still was — a volunteer with 4Cantons RHAP

He started playing rugby with the Monflanquin junior team in 1966, but spent most of his rugby career at the nearby Saint-Aubin club, after marrying Dany, a Saint-Aubinoise. In the 1990s, he returned to his favorite club, US Monflanquinoise, to play for a few years with his childhood friends.

Everyone remembers the player Robert GALLET: an impressive build from a young age, a true force of nature. He played "up front," preferably as a number 8, but didn't hesitate to play as a prop!

He was an exemplary and respected player on all the pitches of Périgord-Agenais.

Since the 2000s, he has remained close to the club, notably joining the first "kitchen" team. In 2014, following the death of Jean-Luc BOISSERIE, president of USM, he became co-president of the club alongside Bertrand PAILLÉ and Laurent DELPIT.

Robert was a loyal supporter of the 4 Cantons BHAP club, whose values he shared and appreciated: commitment, solidarity and conviviality.

Robert GALLET remains a fine Monflanquin personality. He was very attached to his community. We thank his family for coming to the rugby match of federal 1, 4 cantons BHAP / Bergerac in Monflanquin where a heartfelt tribute was paid to him.

August ended with an evening of piano and poetry in the beautiful setting of the Grange de Piquemil.

Alongside the associations, our entire municipal team is mobilizing to try to be present at each event according to the tastes and availability of each person, but in all cases we support cultural, festive and sporting events because they make the reputation of our town and contribute to its influence.

The town hall offers a new service allowing you to certify your digital identity, "France identité ." A certified digital identity allows you to access numerous online services that require a high level of assurance, comparable to in-person verification.

How to proceed?

- Submit a request on the France Identité application.
 Go to the town hall with your identity document.
- 3. An officer verifies your identity by comparing your fingerprints with those contained in your document.
- 4. Your digital identity is certified and you can access new online services.

PLEASE NOTE: For security reasons, only iOS (>16) and Android phones with a system higher than 10 will allow you to obtain certification of your France Identité digital identity.

FACADES SUBSIDY AND JOINERY

The municipality of Monflanguin has revised its support system for the renovation of facades within the defined perimeter of the town center.

From now on, owners can benefit from a subsidy covering 25% of the total cost of facade and carpentry work, up to a limit of €1,500 per application.

Obtaining all planning permission is mandatory before work begins, and the grant will only be paid if the work complies with the planning decree and the regulations in force.
